This course is ideal for those wanting to further their energy medicine practice as a yoga teacher, acupuncturist or complementary healthcare practitioner. We also welcome those who have no prior experience in therapy or medicine.

The course involves attending 12 lectures (mix of live online (2hrs each) and in-person practicals (4 hours) over 6 months followed by 3 months of supervised in-person clinical training at The Little Buckingham Clinic.

Before undertaking clinical training students must show competence in their practice by successfully passing a point location viva examination and case history taking exercise.

Throughout the lectures, coursework will be set which involves preparatory reading (from our book list) and submitting summarised essays on various topics on the course.
